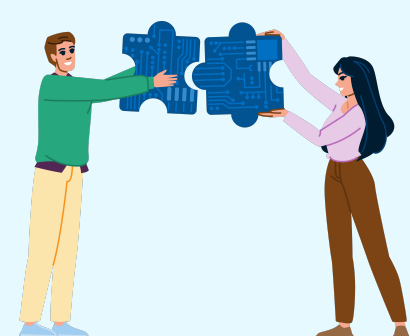


SHOT HUMAN FACTORS AND ERGONOMICS (HFE) IN TRANSFUSION COURSE

What do the courses include?

The role of HFE in improving transfusion safety, application of HFE to incident investigation using the SHOT Human Factors Investigation Tool (HFIT); identification of contributory factors and effective corrective actions, human-centred design principles and safer systems of work



How will the course be delivered?

SHOT team-led presentations, interactive polling and discussion, practical transfusion case studies, and facilitated small-group exercises applying HFE principles and the HFIT.



Who are the courses for?

Any healthcare professional involved in transfusion, quality assurance and patient safety. No prior HFE training is required.



How do I record my learning?

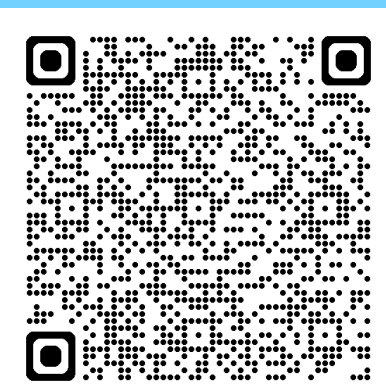
Any way you like, through participation and reflective practice. A certificate will be issued to attendees who attend the full day.
